

Energy Assistance Available for Hartland Residents Through New Opportunities, Inc.

A primary goal of the Town of Hartland's Affordable Housing Plan 2023-2028 is to "Keep residents living safely and affordably in their homes."

New Opportunities, Inc. (NOI) is a community action agency serving Waterbury, Meriden, Torrington and 27 surrounding Connecticut towns including Hartland. The agency provides support for 61,000 people each year by offering a variety of social service programs designed to assist people in need. On behalf of its residents, the Town of Hartland has a contract with NOI's Waterbury office to facilitate applications for NOI's energy assistance program.
